Craft Show
Rules and Regulations
Last Updated 1/15/17

1. All work must be hand crafted or created by the exhibitor. Any work not meeting these criteria will be asked to be removed.
2. No buy/sell.
3. All tents must have weights or be secured to the ground
4. No early packing or leaving. Leaving or packing before the end of the show will result in your not being asked to return.
5. In case of inclement weather, the show committee will decide whether to cancel the show or end the day early. Only the show committee can make this determination.
6. No cars are allowed on the Green.
7. There is no vehicle parking around the Green during show hours. All exhibitors must park at Town Hall or elsewhere.
8. There is no parking in the Eastham Superette lot.
9. All vehicles should be removed from around the Green by 9:30AM. Vehicles should not be brought to the Green until you are packed up and ready to load.
10. Failure to follow the parking regulations can result in your vehicle being towed.
11. The show committee has complete jurisdiction and discretion of show operations.
12. A signed show application is a contract to comply with the Rules and Regulations.
13. Jury process: All first time applicants must submit photos of their work by mail. After the first year jurying is not necessary unless you have substantially changed your work.
 - a. 5 photographs (not slides) representative of your work including a photo of your booth should be included with your application or e-mailed to handsonthearts@gmail.com with your name (Preferred). Photos will not be returned.
 - b. See show application for dates and deadlines.
14. The artist must be present during the majority of the show.
15. We will try to accommodate all space requests; however, we cannot guarantee them.
16. Corner spaces are available on a first come, first served basis for a \$30 fee.
